

WELCOME TO DUBLIN, IRELAND

Dublin is the largest city and capital of Ireland. It is officially known in Irish as Baile Átha Cliath or Áth Cliath; the English name comes from the Irish Dubh-Linn meaning "black pool". Dublin airport is only 10km (6.2 miles) north of the city. The aircoach (blue bus) from the airport stops outside the Burlington Hotel Conference Centre and most of the hotels in the city.

Dublin is a historical and contemporary cultural centre of Ireland as well as a modern centre of education, the arts, administrative function, economy and industry. The city offers all necessary services for visitors and travellers. Hotels recommended for this conference are within walking distance or a short ride from the conference.

The weather in June is usually very mild, with temperature range 19 - 24°C. However you can also expect some rain showers.
